

Virgin Telco will give unlimited gigs to its customers until 2021

Virgin Telco will give unlimited gigs to its customers' mobile phones until 2021, according to the operator of the Euskaltel group.

Both those who register as new customers before September 25, as well as those who are already subscribers with a fibre contract, will be activated by default as of this Friday, September 11, and will be able to enjoy this offer.

"This new proposal from the operator responds to the spirit in which Virgin Telco was born last May: to offer quadruple play services for fixed and mobile telephony, Internet and television in premium qualities, through a differentiated offering. A format that breaks the traditional closed packages so that the consumer can configure a contract in their own way, choosing only what they need, saving unnecessary costs and benefiting from the best final price." Virgin says in a statement.

From March to June, Euskaltel has grown by 11,300 new customers, of which 6,500 come from Virgin Telco, 57% of the total, achieved in just one month since its launch nationwide.
